Water Utility Department



Water Utility is awaiting official determination of the proposed rate increase from Milwaukee Water works. In September the Public Service Commission ruled in favor of the wholesale communities to **reduce** the projected 27% rate increase to a **much smaller** number for the communities that purchase water from Milwaukee. While the exact rate increase is not yet known, the decision by

the PSC is anticipated to save the rate payers in the Village \$100,000 annually from the original rate increase.

DPW/Public Works Department

GOODWILL STORE: The Goodwill project located in the North/West quadrant of W. Schroeder Drive and N. Green Bay Avenue/South 57th is making good progress. All of the site clearing & grubbing has been completed. Current work includes site grading. The estimated project completion date is spring of 2015.

SANITARY SEWER: The Sanitary Sewer Technician is working on routine cleaning throughout the Village sanitary sewer collection system using the newly purchased CJ 1600 jetter unit. Routine sanitary sewer cleaning is mandated by the WDNR and MMSD through the Village's wastewater discharge permit.



STORMWATER: The Stormwater Technician is working on routine street sweeping in the curb & gutter areas. Priority street sweeping is given to the curb & gutter neighborhoods, especially during leaf season, to keep debris from collecting within adjacent storm sewer grates. Please help by clearing any leaves or debris you may see.



TREE-TRIMMING CONTINUES: DPW crews are marking trees for trimming. Additionally, Asplundh, contractor for WE-Energies, has started trimming trees adjacent to power lines throughout the Village.

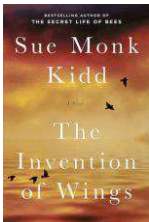
Community Development Department

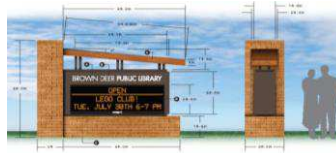
The book for October 15th

"The Invention of Wings" by Sue Monk Kidd

The story follows Hetty 'Handful' Grimke, a Charleston slave, and Sarah, the daughter of the wealthy Grimke family. The novel begins on Sarah's 11th birthday, when she is given ownership over Handful, who is to be her handmaid.

"The Invention of Wings" follows the next 35 years of their lives. Inspired in part by the historical figure of Sarah Grimke (a feminist, suffragist and, importantly, an abolitionist), Kidd allows herself to go beyond the record to flesh out the inner lives of all the characters, both real and imagined.

Library Use in September: Total checkouts have again increased from the previous year! More than 1,000 adult items were checked out this September than in 2013, and almost 500 children's items! This makes a combined total of 16,426 items circulating in the last month!



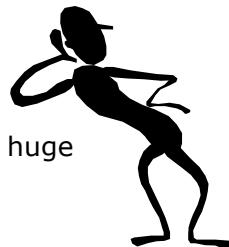
Keep a look out for our new sign!
