## Community Development Department

The Community Development Director and Zoning and Planning Specialist met with representatives of Milwaukee County Transit to plan the layout of a newly approved bus route that will run east/ west through the Village. The Route 276 will run from approximately N. Park Plaza to the intersection of W. Schroeder Drive and N. Green Bay Road.

The service will utilize W. Brown Deer Road and also pass through the Brown Deer Industrial and Business Parks. It is proposed to run every half hour from 5:00am until 10:00pm. Further planning is required to establish final timetables, routes, stops and services. The new route is proposed to begin service in spring of 2015.



The Zoning and Planning Specialist coordinated final maps and exhibits for the Comprehensive Outdoor Recreation Plan and reserved the Lois and Tom Dolan Community Center for a public open house meeting to solicit feedback on the Plan.

The meeting is scheduled for January 20th from 5:00-7:00pm at the Community Center, 4355 W. Bradley Rd.

Session 1 swim lessons (starting the week of 1/17) will go on as scheduled. Lessons will resume in June after the pool shutdown.

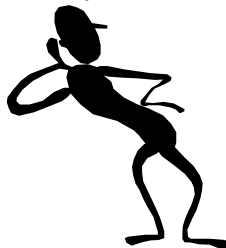
