
GENERAL: The Director attended the Public Information Meeting (PIM) for the W. Bradley Road reconstruction & N. 50th Street ditch rehabilitation project last week on Wednesday, April 1st from 5:00pm to 7:00pm in the Lois & Tom Dolan Community Center. Residents and business owners were invited to the meeting where project details related to construction staging, detour routes, and schedules were presented. The key project contacts for the contractor, on-site engineer, and Village were also introduced. Residents were able to ask questions and view the design plans for the project which is scheduled to start on Monday, May 4th.



SANITARY SEWER: The Sanitary Sewer Technician is working on televising sewer mains throughout the Village this week as per the Village's wastewater discharge permit with the WDNR. The Sewer Technician is also working on televising a storm sewer line located between N. 45th Street and the N. Green Bay Road service drive. A reoccurring drainage problem is present at this location and investigative work is being completed to determine pipe sizes, pipe conditions, etc. It is suspected that the inlet pipe is undersized. A future project will likely occur in the near future to correct the issue.

STORMWATER: The Stormwater Technician has started the spring street sweeping schedule. All Village roadways will be swept at least once throughout the month of April. As per the Village's WDNR stormwater permit all roadways are swept with extra attention given to the curb & gutter areas.
