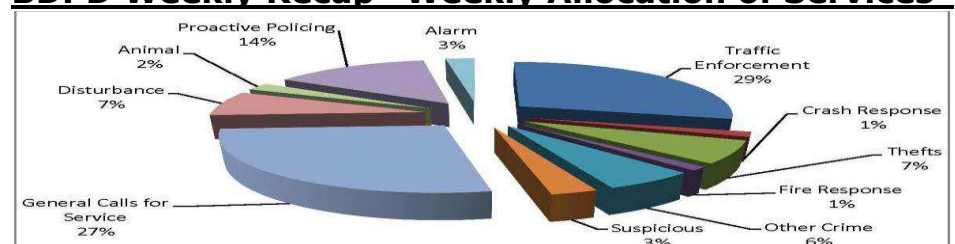

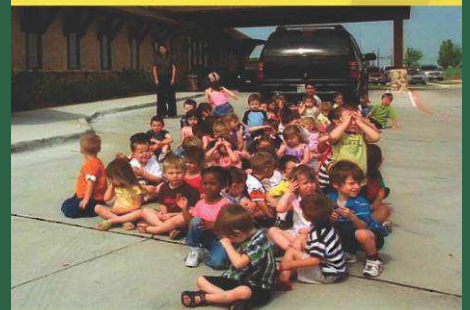
Weekly Health Tip
