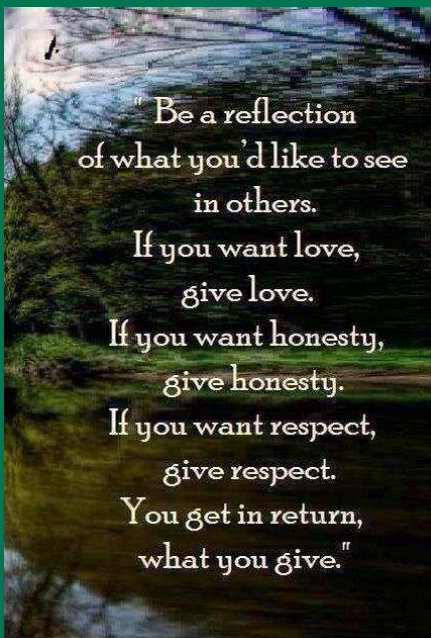

NORTH SHORE HEALTH DEPARTMENT

The Health Department does multiple tuberculosis skin tests every month for students, new employees, and yearly tests for people working in health care or daycare settings. Not only do we provide TB skin tests, we also follow up on any tests that are positive in the North Shore. If the TB skin test is positive, more testing may be needed to determine if it was a false positive or if the patient has latent or active tuberculosis. The health department then works with the state and the client's physician to provide treatment for latent or active tuberculosis.

A public health nurse attended a training to learn about a **Functional Assessment Service Team (FAST)**. These teams provide service and reasonable accommodations to people with access and functional needs in a shelter setting after a disaster. The training helps to provide proper planning prior to an incident. During an incident the FAST will help assess people with access and functional needs when entering a reception center or shelter and help them get what they need to safely stay there. This may include access to medications, assistive equipment, providing/determining additional ways of communication, or safe transportation after the incident clears.

Every year in our country over one million people are diagnosed with skin cancer & as a result, one person dies every hour of simple skin cancer.

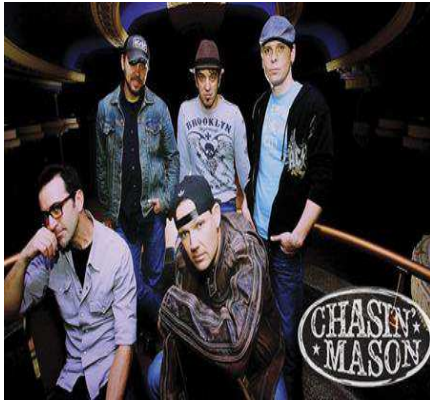
Reasons to protect you & your family! Always use a sunscreen with an SPF of 15 or higher.

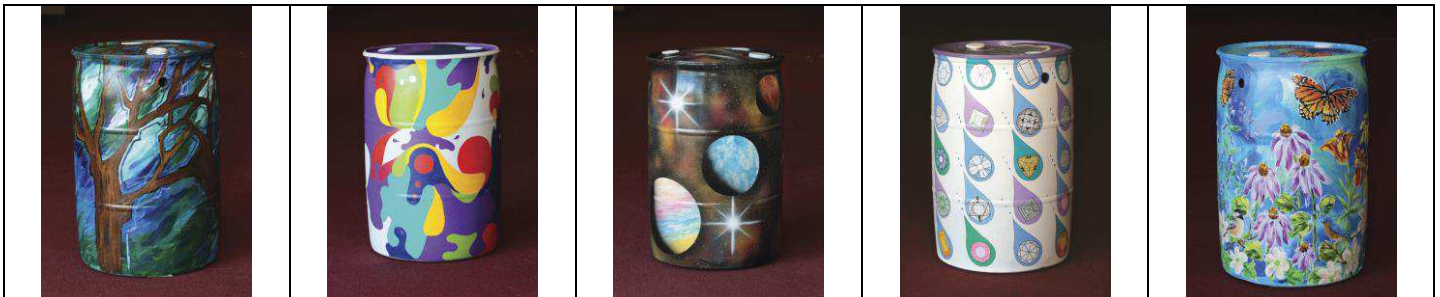
Community Vibes Summer Concert Series
