




NORTH SHORE HEALTH DEPARTMENT

Each year, more than 4.5 million people in the U.S. are bitten by dogs and over 800,000 of those require medical attention. The most common victims are children and senior citizens.



Any dog or cat bite should be reported to the police or health department. Follow up will then be completed in accordance with Wisconsin State Statute 95.21, the rabies control program. This includes confining the animal for 10 days and completing three checkups by a veterinarian.

Tips to prevent dog/cat/animal bites:

- Learn and respect canine body language
- Keep dogs inside (not chained or left outside alone)
- Don't disturb a dog while sleeping or eating
- Don't allow children to climb on, grab or tug at a dog
- Teach children proper ways to show affection
- Ask before petting a strange dog
- Work with puppies on bite inhibition
- Seek professional help for aggressive behavior



Infected Ash Tree






Community Vibes Summer Concert Series
