**End-of-Season Dog Swim Brown Deer Pond is going to the dogs!** Dogs are invited to swim at the end of the Pond season from 4:00-7:00 pm on Monday, August 24th, & 11:00am-2:00pm on Saturday, August 29th.

The Pond is fully enclosed & the perfect spot for your beloved pooch to play run & swim.

**The following guidelines must be followed:**

- Dogs must be on a leash when entering the Pond.
- Only dogs with an adult or youth age 12 & older may enter.
- Individuals may wade waist-deep in Pond water.
- Balls & soft-thrown toys are allowed. No sticks!
- Individuals must bring a bag and pick up their dog's waste.
- Only well-socialized & friendly dogs will be allowed.

**The fee is \$5.00 per dog.**

**In addition, donations will be collected for the Wisconsin Humane Society. Register at the Pond entrance.**

## **NORTH SHORE HEALTH DEPARTMENT**

Staff presented information on pedestrian, bike, & medication safety at Brown Deer's Night Out For Justice. Many residents went home with North Shore totes, reflecting safety lights, & poison control stickers or magnets. The event was well attended & other community leaders in attendance included: BD Police Dept., North Shore Fire/Rescue, BD Public Works, BD Parks & Recreation, WI Dept. of Corrections & many others.

Staff participated in presenting the Second Chance program with the Brown Deer Police Department. The health department engaged youth in an interactive discussion about healthy life choices. Topics discussed included bullying prevention, infant co-sleeping, prenatal care, immunizations.

## **Weekly Health Tip**

During the summer months, many people take food on the road with them. Whether it is a day trip to the beach, a few days on the boat, or a week in an RV or at a campground, make sure that the food you pack remains safe to eat.

For example, pack perishable foods directly from the refrigerator or freezer into the cooler. Meat & poultry should be frozen. A full cooler will maintain cold temperatures longer than a partially filled cooler. Store the cooler in the shade and cover it with a light-colored blanket or tarp to reflect heat.

## **Village Feasibility Study – Update**

After conducting a Feasibility Study on Brown Deer municipal buildings, consultants from Bray Architects identified the pressing need for major repairs and upgrades to the Department of Public Works Complex.

From this analysis two viable alternatives were presented to the Village Board: 1) Repair the current 1966 Public Works buildings in the Original Village neighborhood or 2) Pursue the construction of a new facility south of the existing Village Hall site.

The Village Board has directed Village staff and Bray Architects to further present these findings to the public. Residents are invited to any of the following events to gain an understanding of the issues and alternatives:

The Village of Brown Deer is pleased to exciting evenings of outdoor concerts this summer at beautiful Village Park (right next to Village Hall).


